# March PTA Planning Meeting March 5th, 2020 Stoney Point Recreation Center

The meeting was called to order at 6:12 pm.

- 1. Approval of Minutes: Kim made a motion to approve the minutes from February's planning meeting and Shivani seconded. All above voted to approve.
- 2. Treasurer Report (Shivani Kohut): Shivani gave a report of the income and expenses for 1 29 February. Beginning of the month (1 February) balance was \$31,328.33. Income was \$5,935.94 and came from Amazon Smile, Popcorn, Spirit Sticks, Walkathon sponsorship and yearbooks. Expenses were \$1,711.07 for spirit sticks (Bus rider of the month donation) and walkathon prizes. Shivani also made two additional points:
  - We have not sold any of the Scrip Gift Cards we purchased so those are available to anyone who would like to buy
- 3. Introductions: We had a new volunteer (Ingrid, 5<sup>th</sup> grade celebration) so Amy asked all volunteers to introduce themselves.
- 4. SpaceWalk (Kim Witczak):
  - We've raised a little over \$7K to date. 99 pledges closes on March 12th; all envelopes are due March 13<sup>th</sup>.
  - Our mid-week Space Mission was very successful (free Bubba's kids meal for anyone that gets a donation of \$25 or more on a specific day). Raised over \$2K in under 24 hours. Information on a second will be out soon (Sonic prize pack).
  - ➤ Gaga Ball for winning classes is set for the afternoon of March 27<sup>th</sup> for K-2 winner and the morning of April 6<sup>th</sup> for the 3-5 winner.

- ➤ Poster judging has been moved to march 12<sup>th</sup>. Kim announced she needs 4-5 volunteers. Jessica Odenbaugh, Shay Johnson, Ashley Adams and Amy Garrett volunteered.
- Signup Genius for Space Walk volunteers will go out soon. All volunteers participating MUST have a clearance from CCS through the volunteer program. Parents can signup/show up to walk with just their kids but they must be cleared in the system.

### 5. Yearbook (Lindsey Condry):

- Yearbook initial proof is complete. Handed off to Amy for review and then she will pass to Mr. Tucker.
- Final day for pre-orders was February 28<sup>th</sup>. We will continue to accept preorders for a short grace period (1-2 weeks) but this will not be advertised.
- \* We intend to order 150 extra books as we have done the last two years.

## 6. Spirit Events:

- \* March 14<sup>th</sup> Movie Morning (Onward); Doors open at 9am; movie starts at 10am. Flyers have gone out for those that want to pre-purchase tickets. Money is due back by March 12<sup>th</sup>. Tickets may be purchased from the PTA on the morning of the movie. Must pay in cash or check.
- \* April 3<sup>rd</sup> Stoney Point Family Night at the Marksmen Hockey Game. Last game of the season. This is not a fundraiser; all we get is a group rate on tickets.

# 7. 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Celebration:

- Volunteer coordinator had her initial meeting with Ms. Karis who indicated she didn't want a specific theme.
- She understands that all the PTA does is donate \$500 to cover DJ and other small expenses.
- \* Will continue to refine her plan (theme, games) and let the PTA know where she could use volunteers so that we can put out a volunteer call.
- 8. PTA Board and Event Chairpersons: Amy announced that we are currently accepting nominations for board positions. Voting will take place at the general PTA meeting on May 7<sup>th</sup>. Interested volunteers should contact Amy.
- 9. Candy Grams: The group decided to do Candy Grams this year around EOG testing and voted to do Tootsie Pops (instead of Blow Pops). Order forms will go home on April 27<sup>th</sup>, will be due back May 8<sup>th</sup> and will be delivered May 11<sup>th</sup>.
- 10. PTA Board and Committee Chairpersons: Amy announced that we're currently accepting nominations for all board positions and committee chairpersons. Voting for the board will take place at the General PTA Meeting on May 7<sup>th</sup>.

11. Principal/Vice Principal Remarks: Mrs. Velazquez thank the PTA for the Bus Rider of Month Spirit Sticks and provided the date for the volunteer appreciation lunch (April 23<sup>rd</sup>, 9am - 10am).

- \* Mandy provided an update on Grants. She submitted her first which was to Aldi for \$5K for Chromebooks. She's also looking at Walmart for a similar grant. There was some concern that we had to purchase a specific charging station (known as a COW or Computer on Wheels) and Mrs. Velazquez agreed to look in to it for us. Mandy is also looking at music related grants to get storage lockers for instruments and would also like to get a wish list of items from Resource teachers that she can use to find grants.
- \* Amy asked that anyone with newsletter input send that as soon as possible.
- 13. Next planning meeting is scheduled for April 2<sup>nd</sup> at 6pm in the small room of the Rec Center.
