Amy called the meeting to order at 6:06 pm.

- 1. There were several new volunteers so we started with introductions.
 - Laura O'Berry attended as a teacher representative.
 - Rachel Andrews has volunteered for candy grams.
 - Mandy Kirchgessnor has volunteered to help with grant writing.
- 2. Approval of Minutes: Lindsey made a motion to approve the minutes from the September planning meeting, Kim seconded the motion and all voted in favor.
- 3. Treasurer Report (Shivani): Shivani gave a report of the income and expenses for 10 September 3 October (see attached for details). Beginning of month (10 September) balance was \$26,777.28. Income was \$3013.26 and came from membership, spirit stick and spirit wear sales and the September Popcorn. Expenses were \$1,413.98 (leveled readers closeout from last year; teacher reimbursements, spirit sticks, and other miscellaneous fees).
- 4. Fundraising (Kim):
 - Spirit Nights: Melissa Burnette has agreed to serve as Spirit Night Chair. Marksmen Night is set for March 21st. Still working other dates. Looking to provide more than just restaurants so that families have more options.

- Kim is still working with the vendor to determine what type of bottle filling stations we'd need if we decide to do a fundraiser for that. A volunteer with experience related to these bottle filling stations advised Kim to confirm that they would be installed by the county and that we would not have to cover installation costs.
- Move Morning is set with Millstone for November 2nd. Movies are Arctic Dogs and Addams Family. Doors open at 9am, movies start at 10. STPES families pay \$8 per ticket (\$1.58 goes back to STPES PTA). \$1 popcorn and drinks available.
- Chu-Chun Fu has volunteered to run the SCRIP program. More information to follow.

4. Membership Drive (Shay):

- Member count: 288
- Mrs. Huttinger's class won the K-2 category with 12 members. Mrs. Hamilton's class won the 3-5 category with 17 members.
- Both classes chose pizza party.
- Several of the new members asked about the benefits of membership. After some discussion centered around advocacy at the national level and a voice at the local level the group agreed that it would be helpful to provide something formal (infographic for social media + brief pitch at December General Membership Meeting) that addresses, at a minimum, the following topics:
 - o What do I get out of my membership?
 - o What happens to the \$8 they pay?

5. Free to Schools (Joanna):

- Box Tops: Total earnings to date is \$723.30. Mrs. Sanderson's class won the top prize for the first submission period.
- Coke Rewards: Input issue has been resolved. Everyone that drinks these products is encouraged to go on line to submit for their points or send in their tops and labels for Joanna to input.

The group voted to order 40 pizzas from Little Caesars. Kim will coordinate for pick up and drop off at the school.
